



County Line drug dealing is the practice of metropolitan crime gangs supplying drugs in Sussex towns. **Dealers exploit the vulnerable** and often **take over their properties** in order to store and deal drugs at the address – **this is known as cuckooing** 

## Signs of cuckooing

- Individuals taking over a vulnerable resident's address
- Vulnerable people scared, threatened or coerced
- Frequent or high numbers of visitors at the address
- Signs of drug misuse including deal bags and weighing scales
- Individuals with large amounts of cash or multiple mobile phones

A cuckooed address represents a significant risk to the individuals being cuckooed and to the wider community
