Domestic Abuse: DASH, MARAC and Safety Planning - ONLINE - FREE

Training courses open to professionals in East Sussex.

To raise awareness and increase understanding in addressing domestic abuse including coercion and control; to recognise signs and symptoms and develop confidence in assessing risk and safety planning.

Switchboard are a 'By and For' led service who provide support to LGBTQ+ survivors through their Independent Domestic Violence Advisors (IDVAs).

They offer a wide range of training options including information sessions, interactive workshops and full day courses. See training menu attached for further information:



Hourglass

Hourglass are the only UK-wide charity dedicated to calling time on the harm, abuse and exploitation of older people. Their confidential services provide information and support to an older person or anyone concerned about an older person who is at risk of, experiencing or recovering from any form of abuse. The types of harm and abuse might include physical, financial, psychological, sexual or neglect.

They offer 90 minute training sessions for upto 30 people (Online £200 / Face to Face £320). The sessions include:

- The dynamics of elder abuse, domestic elder abuse and coercive control.
- Information on spotting the signs of abuse.
- Analysis of how age can create barriers to accessing support including technological exclusion, housing, family dynamics and adult safeguarding.
- Interactive case study aimed at building confidence in aiding real-life disclosures.
- Open question forum for staff.
- Presentation slides provided in PDF for staff reference.
- Advice on signposting to Hourglass 24/7 helpline and support options.
