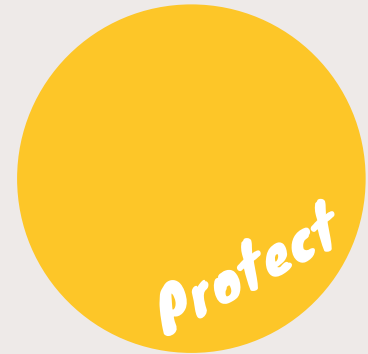


Personal Identity

The **opinions** you hold about the **world** e.g. killing is bad.



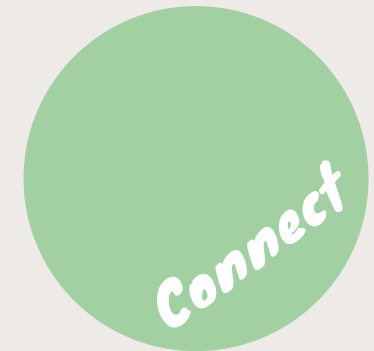
Values

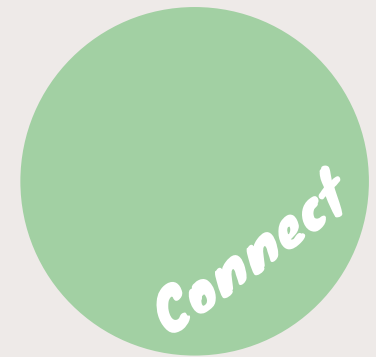
Ethnic Group

Relates to the **grouping** of people based on **physical characteristics**, such as skin colour.



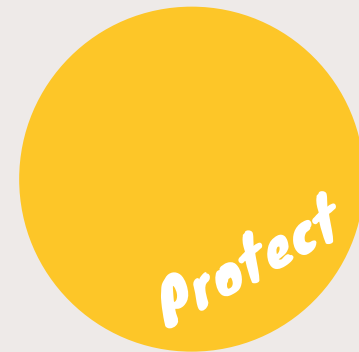
National Identity

A persons identity and sense of **belonging** to a **country**.



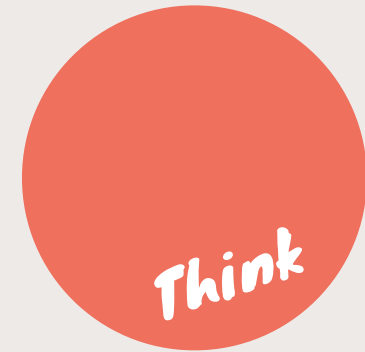
British Values

A way of thinking about an **individual** or **group** of people **before** we even **know** them.



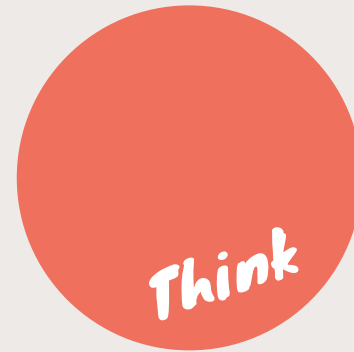

Extremist Groups

The process of how an individual or group comes to adopt **increasingly extreme beliefs and views.**



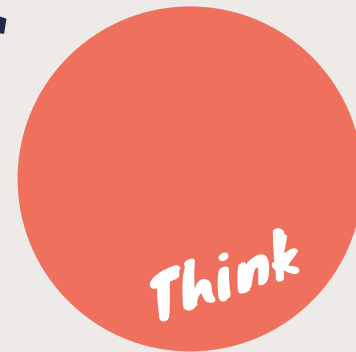
Online Grooming
